

Eco Superhero Poster Competition

Age 3 – 12

Deadline: 14th October

About this competition

To engage children in learning for sustainability, this poster competition explores environmental issues with children in early, first, and second level of CfE.

Pupils will complete a worksheet, select a catchphrase, and design a poster. Teachers may choose to give pupils the opportunity to discuss climate change and what actions can be taken locally to tackle the climate emergency, and/or use this resource as an entry into further work, such as creative writing.

Learning objectives

After taking part in this competition, pupils will be able to:

- Understand that human activity has an impact on the environment
- Identify and discuss some environmental challenges
- Discuss actions that can be taken to reduce our impact on the environment, such as recycling
- Reflect on strategies to positively engage with friends, family, and the wider community to promote change

Wider context and further learning

The poster competition is designed to enable discussions about last year's COP26, and the deadline has been chosen to coincide with Youth Climate Action Day 2022. Both events provide an opportunity for wider discussion and further learning.
